# SOCALPAPA Art of Nature Show 2022 DISPLAY SHOW INSTRUCTIONS

(Please Read Carefully before registering)

### **GRID SETUP**

Participants using grid set-up: Each artist must use a set of three (3) black grids, each measuring 2'wide x 6' tall, plus nameplates, and badges and will partner with another artist of your choosing or be assigned a partner. The six (three per artist) grids will be linked side-by-side in a zig-zag or "H" configuration (see photos below), secured with black zip ties. (Do not use metal clamps.)

### TRAIL LOCATIONS

Participants with trail location: These locations are along a dirt path in a nature setting away from the main patio area. Trail locations are perfect for the artist who doesn't have a lot of framed work or grids. Artists can display art in bins, easels and table top easels. There are two 9 foot picnic tables under a covered pavilion and one 10x10 area that is level and can be covered by a popup. A badge is required for these locations.

## **SPACE ASSIGNMENTS**

See the time and space assignment list (both grid and trail) for your number on the map and for your arrival time (emailed to you prior to the show). Please arrive at your assigned time, as it helps us with traffic control, quick move-in, and set-up. The person you are sharing with depends upon you to arrive on time.

Water, snacks and a chair will be provided both days of the Display Show. Lunch will be the responsibility of the artist and can be brought in a cooler which should be placed in the ENC Center. All water bottles MUST be reusable; no plastic in keeping with ENC's zero waste policy which you MUST comply with and can be read here.

# Unloading and Display Set-Up: Saturday, April 30th

Please arrive at your scheduled time. Enter the driveway off of 16th Street. No more than six (6) vehicles at a time will be allowed to enter the unloading area. Unload your grids and paintings. Move them to your assigned space, which will be marked with tape and arrow on the patio floor or find the sign on the trail. There will be a limited number of roller carts to share so please bring your own if possible.

After unloading, move your vehicle immediately to the parking available at the Newport Harbor High School on Irvine Ave. between 16th st. and 15th st. Please park in the back of the lot to allow visitors to park closer. Then return to set up your display. At 4:00 p.m., move your paintings, hooks, and nameplates inside the ENC Center for overnight storage. Only the grids will remain on the patio overnight. On Sunday, May 1st set up is from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. At

4:00 p.m., pack up everything, leaving the ENC Center patio and trails clean of paintings, grids, zip ties, tape, easels etc. Help your fellow artists clean up so we will be invited back again.

# **Display Show Rules**

- Original work only. No prints or reproductions. ART CARDS and Studio are work okay,
- Subject matter: Plein Air Painting (i.e., landscape, seascape, cityscape, floral), no nudes, no figurative (figures in landscape okay), no portraiture.
- Paintings must be appropriately framed. Paintings must be backed in black or brown coverbacking and ready to hang.
- Title and price cards are encouraged to be printed or typed. No paintings on the ground.
   Grids may not be fabric backed.
- No framed paintings priced under \$200 and unframed under \$125. SOCALPAPA name plates on grids and name badges on your person are required. No flowers or chairs other than those provided by ENC.
- All extra paintings and packing material must be stored in the vehicle or the ENC Center.
   No boxes, personal effects or tables are to be next to the display.

There will be canopies for the art and for shade for the artists. If you are not under or near a canopy, a small handheld umbrella for shade is permitted.

This is not the time to show your individuality (except in your work.) Our goal is to have a cohesive and professional looking exhibit. Last Rule: Have Fun.

## **SALES**

Sales slips will be provided. Print hard so that it transfers through to all three (3) sheets. The patron fills out name, address, and phone number, and then takes the entire form to the ENC Center front desk to pay. The patron then returns to you for the painting with the yellow copy stamped as proof of payment. ENC will process all sales (cash, check, and credit card), collect sales tax, and approximately a month after the event issue checks to the artists (70 percent of the sale price) along with the pink copies of the sales slips.
